



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2019 AURORA YOUNG PHILANTHROPIST OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Aurora Women and Girls Foundation is seeking nominations for its 2019 *Young Philanthropist of the Year* award. This annual award was created to recognize young women leaders in Greater Hartford. Eligible nominees are young women between the ages of 14 and 18 years old (current high school freshmen, sophomores or juniors) who are doing great things in their community. Whether cleaning up a beach, working in a food pantry, raising funds for a local shelter or teaching a group of kids to dance, we are looking for a young woman who is providing leadership and inspiration to benefit her community.

The selected honoree will be recognized as Aurora's 2019 Young Philanthropist of the Year at our annual **Signature Event** on Friday, November 1, 2019. She will have an opportunity to share her experiences through a short address to attendees as a part of the event program.

Eligibility and Nomination Process:

- Eligible candidates are young women between 14 and 18 years of age (current high school freshman, sophomore or junior) from the Greater Hartford area who are active in their community.
- A completed nomination form (enclosed) is required to be eligible and should detail how the nominee has demonstrated leadership and excellence in supporting a cause to make a difference in the community.
- Nominations may not be completed by family members. Self-nominations are accepted.

An Aurora Women and Girls Foundation committee oversees the nomination process and recommends an honoree to the Aurora Foundation Board for approval. All applications will be reviewed, a select few will be invited to participate in a face-to-face interview with the committee in April/May, and one young woman will be selected as the Young Philanthropist of the Year.
